REGIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

W.B. Small Trust Iowa Seminary Scholarships

An applicant must be a full-time Christian student working on a Masters of Divinity at an accredited seminary and have a strong Iowa connection. Scholarship recipients will be chosen during the third week of June on the basis of their financial need, Iowa connection, and academic record, statement of faith and letters of recommendation. Students selected every June receive \$2,500 annually; the scholarships are renewable for two additional years if needed.
