

## Project Bridges Tuition Scholarship Denver Seminary | Capital Region Campus Only

A special tuition 25% scholarship is available to Denver Seminary students enrolled in programs offered at the Washington, DC campus. Course/program fees, technology fees, etc... are not included. To apply for this tuition scholarship, students must complete the application form as instructed below. Students may re-apply each academic year.

### Guidelines:

1. To be eligible to apply the student must be one of the following:

- a member/employee in good standing at a church that is a member of Project Bridges.
- an employee of an organization that is a member of Project Bridges.

2. Completion of this form does not guarantee admission to Denver Seminary. Applicants must complete the regular admissions process and be accepted as a student. 3. Eligible students must comply with all rules, regulations, policies and standards of Denver Seminary and must maintain satisfactory academic progress per program guidelines. If the academic standard is not met, the student will not be eligible until his/her GPA meets the minimum requirements.

4. Acceptance of this tuition scholarship may reduce the amount of or make a student ineligible for other forms of financial aid from Denver Seminary. Eligible applicants may apply and receive federal and/or state financial aid in accordance with applicable regulations and guidelines.

5. This form should be submitted each academic year at least two weeks but not more than six weeks prior to the start of class.

### Procedures:

1. Applicant must complete and sign Section 1 of the form and then submit the application to his/her church/organization.

2. Church/organization must complete and sign Section 2 of the form and then send it to Project Bridges via FAX at 301-262-0305 or EMAIL scan to [info@projectbridges.org](mailto:info@projectbridges.org). The church/organization should notify the applicant when the form has been sent to Project Bridges.

3. Project Bridges will complete and sign Section 3 of the form and then send the form to Denver Seminary's Financial Aid Office. Project Bridges will send the applicant an email confirming that the application has been completed and sent to Denver Seminary.
